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## **About:**

The purpose of the Fellowship is to provide funding annually for one CALL member to attend the Law via the Internet Conference, an initiative of the Legal Information Institutes worldwide that constitute the Free Access to Law Movement. Expenses up to a maximum of \$2,500 will be covered.

## **Guidelines:**

- All members of CALL/ACBD who have been in good standing for a minimum of twelve months are eligible to apply for the Fellowship.
- The applicant's résumé, letter of application, and at least two letters of reference will form the basis of selection. In their letter of application, applicants should outline how attendance at the conference will benefit them in their current position and/or in their career as a law librarian.
- The successful applicant will write a report of the conference for publication in the Canadian Law Library Review.
