2023 TALL & CALL/ACBD Salary Survey

This is a joint salary survey report from the Toronto Association of Law Libraries (TALL) and the Canadian Association of Law Libraries / L'Association canadienne des bibliothèques de droit (CALL/ACBD). The purpose is to determine benchmark employment remuneration received by members.

This survey reports data collected in February/March 2023. The previous survey was conducted in 2018. This analysis is based on 204 survey responses. Respondents were able to skip questions, which results in different "totals" for individual questions throughout this report.

Many thanks to Kim Clarke for conducting the data analysis for this report.

Notes on the Questionnaire

The committee has added two new questions to the survey this year:

- Question 27: How many days per week are you permitted to work from home?
- Question 29: In a typical work week, how many hours do you work in excess of the basic number of hours stated on your employment contract?

These questions were added to capture data on overwork and remote work policies. Both topics are especially relevant following the COVID-19 lockdowns and remain of interest to individuals seeking employment in this field.

Notes on the Report

This report contains two parts. **Part I** displays the average salaries of members based on respondents' answers to specific questions. **Part II** includes member responses for each individual question.

Where zero respondents selected an option, it is not included in the corresponding graph. Please consult the table below each chart for a full list of response options. Data was not reported if the privacy of respondents would not be assured due to the low number of responses. This means that some average salaries could not be reported. For example, we did not conduct any cross-tabulation analysis on average hourly wages due to the small number of respondents who reported earning an hourly wage.

Salary data was collected in ranges (e.g. \$70,001-\$75,000) and averages were determined using the midpoint of these ranges (e.g. \$72,500). This presented a problem for the uppermost salary range (\$125,001+). \$130,000 was used for this option in cross-tabulation (which is consistent with previous survey reports); please note that, as a result, this report may underestimate salaries. The committee recommends that the next iteration of the survey include a higher salary ceiling to allow for the calculation of more precise averages.




Average Salary by Education Level



Average Salary by Years in the Profession





Average Salary by Library Type





Average Salary by Number of Employees Supervised








Average Salary by Gender



Q1: What province or territory do you primarily work in?
















Q8: In which type of library do you work?


Q9: Including yourself, please indicate the total number of staff in your law library or department (do not include student workers).





Q10: Please indicate the number of employees you supervise or manage (both full- and part-time).





Q11: Approximately how many legal professionals and law students are directly served by your law library or department?















Q18: Have you changed positions in the past year?











Q22: Do you have some degree of control over which benefits make up your total benefit package?







Q24: Does your employer provide funding for you to attend continuing education programs such as conferences or courses?





Q25: Does your employer provide paid time for you to attend continuing education programs such as conferences or courses?







Q27: How many days per week are you permitted to work from home?







Q29: In a typical work week, how many hours do you work in excess of the basic number of hours stated on your employment contract?






Q31: With which of the following genders do you identify?
